Returning professionals must re-apply annually and are voted onto the PSC professional staff by the PSC Board of Directors but do not have to submit a resume once one is on file. Those applying for full staff and non full staff professional membership will follow this same process*****

Any Professional who does not pay the \$150 annual membership fee will be required to pay a \$10/day coaching fee. These coaches will not be permitted to teach from the boards or on the ice until this fee is paid, and they have provided a copy of their liability insurance and USFS membership card to a PSC Board member

Professional Membership \$150.00 (no activity fee)

This membership class is for the skating professional and entitles the member to:

- Teaching privileges on PSC club ice.
- Professional members must be approved by the PSC Board and agree to abide by the PSC Professional Code of Conduct.
- Be 18 years or older
- Be a current member of USFS with membership thru PSC or another club, current PSA Member and current liability insurance
- Learn to Skate USA certification by Sept 1st, 2018 *(PSC will reimburse this fee for full staff coaches)*
- Pass the CORI check and appropriate CER exams

Included and Required with the PSC Staff Coach membership:

- \$60 USFS membership fee is included with \$150 Professional contract fee
- No Charge for Home Club Coaches at Annual PSC Banquet
- Staff coaches are **required** to have passed the USFS Intermediate FS or higher, or USFS Silver Dance tests or higher and should have a CER level
- LTS: Will be put in rotation of PSC's Learn to Skate Program, and given the opportunity to acquire Learn to Skate students for private lessons. PSC representing coach's are **required** to teach at least one session of Learn to Skate over the contract period *(June 2018 thru June 2019)*....You will be compensated by PSC for all LTS classes taught.
- Only PSC representing staff coaches will be given the opportunity to choreograph a show number in the annual Icycles show. Coaches are compensated, but in order to receive full compensation when choreographing a show number in Icycles you are required to be at all rehearsals/practices for your assigned group(s), show dress rehearsal and ALL show performances unless approved by Pilgrim Skating Club BOD
- Only PSC Staff coaches will have the opportunity to teach PSC representing skaters on non-club ice times per arranged by Hobomock rink Manager Ron Woodworth.
- 5 volunteer hours required at PSC sponsored events
- Submit a short bio and picture to be displayed on PSC website's Professional page

****Failure to comply with the above required elements will lead to breach of Professional contract and PSC Professional status will be suspended****

AGREEMENT

I understand and agree that if my application is accepted by the PSC, I will abide by all rules, regulations and policies of PSC. I also agree to abide by the **Code of Ethics/Tenets of Professionalism set forth by the Professional Skaters Association (PSA)**. I understand that failure to follow any such rules, regulations or policies may result in a loss of my privileges and the possibility of non- renewal the following year, dependent upon the sole discretion of the PSC Board of Directors.

I understand and agree that I must comply with the U.S. Figure Skating Coaches Registration Process which includes a national screening background process, and that my application will not be approved until this process is complete and my name appears on the USFS registered coaches list.

Assumption Of Risk and Waiver of Liability: I am aware that figure skating is a dangerous sport, and that my participation as a Professional with PSC is at my sole risk. I hereby agree to release, indemnify and hold harmless Pilgrim Skating Club and all of their directors, officers, agents, insurers, attorneys and employees from any and all claims, demands, losses, damages or injury, whatsoever, of any kind or nature, that I may sustain as a result of my participation or activities as a Professional of the PSC.
